

# Legal Fund Appeal

Dear Library Lover,

I want to thank you for your support over the past year. We have accomplished a lot. We have formed a vital nonprofit organization, fighting to prevent the downsizing of Brooklyn Heights Library and to preserve our human-scale neighborhood. It is the first library in Brooklyn to be targeted by the DeBlasio administration, powerful real estate interests, and the Brooklyn Public Library. Since then, two other Brooklyn library properties have become targets for sale and destruction.

Hudson Companies, the proposed developer, has been unable thus far to secure financing and close the deal. Our court case and vigilance has kept the project under ongoing scrutiny but we are far from done.

Last week the court denied our request for a preliminary injunction. While we were certainly disappointed with the Court's denial of our motion, we are proceeding with the appeal as well as making a motion to expedite it. Hudson Companies will be at risk for any demolition or construction of the planned residential tower if we are ultimately successful with the case.
